- Ensure all employees are regularly and appropriately vetted (DBS Checked)
- Ensure that detailed and accurate accounts are kept of any safeguarding concerns and remain confidential

MCC will review this safeguarding policy every 2 years or sooner should there be any changes in legislation or as result of any significant safeguarding incidents.
